Rules and Expectations

Please **initial** next to each as an acknowledgment that you and your parent/guardian have read these rules & expectations, understand them and agree to follow them.

_____ Students shall be present at all team meetings, meals and matches.

_____ All Chaperones, Mentors and FMA Volunteers are in a position of authority. They will be respected and their instructions will be followed.

_____ Unplanned trips from the competition site or hotel shall not be permitted.

_____ Students must take full responsibility for their personal belongings at all times.

_____ Mentors or chaperones may need to search personal belongings if deemed necessary for the safety and security of all participants. This may include, but is not limited to purses and backpacks.

_____ All students are expected to uphold the FIRST principle of Gracious Professionalism both at the venue and hotel. Disrespectful language or behavior WILL NOT be tolerated.

_____ Students shall not enter any other students rooms during curfew hours.

_____ During non-curfew hours visitation is allowed provided the room door is kept wide open.

_____ Students shall not enter the hotel rooms of people other than Bensalem High School students or Chaperones.



Rules and Expectations (Continued)

_____ Students will keep chaperones and coaches informed of where they will be at all times.

_____ A curfew of 10:00 PM (or ½ hour after the team returns to the hotel, whichever is later) to 6:00 AM and will be enforced each night.

_____ Students must remain in their assigned rooms during curfew hours and may not violate curfew for any reason except for health or safety reasons and in those instances they must notify a coach or chaperone immediately

_____ No drinking, smoking or use of illegal substances.

_____ Students and their families are responsible for any damages to the hotel or team equipment as a result of inappropriate behavior.

_____ The Bensalem High School Student Handbook will be in effect throughout the trip and disciplinary action will be enforced upon return to the school for any violations of it.

Any student found in violation of any of these rules may, at the discretion of the Mentors, be placed on immediate suspension from the team and may have their hotel room assignment changed as a result. If warranted, a parent/guardian or may be required to come to the site and bring the student home at their own expense. Bensalem High School administration will also be notified and disciplinary action may be taken based on the severity of the action.

Additionally, Mentors reserve the right to contact parents/guardians regarding student behavior on this field trip even if it is not in direct violation of the rules and expectations.

This permission will relieve Bensalem High School of any liability incurred in this activity.
